#### MINUTES MOUNTAIN IRON CITY COUNCIL February 21, 2023

Mayor Anderson called the City Council meeting to order at 4:00p.m. with the following members present: Councilor Ed Roskoski, Al Stanaway, Joe Prebeg Jr., Julie Buria and Mayor Peggy Anderson. Also present were: Craig Wainio, City Administrator; Tim Satrang, Public Works Director; Amanda Inmon, Municipal Services Secretary; Lauren Buffetta, City Engineer; and SGT Grant Toma, Sheriff's Department.

It was moved by Prebeg and seconded by Buria the consent agenda be approved as follows:

- 1. Approve the minutes of the February 6, 2023 regular meeting as submitted.
- 2. That the communications be accepted and placed on file and those requiring further action by the City Council be acted upon during their proper sequence on the agenda.
- 3. To acknowledge the receipts for the period February 1-15, totaling \$311,642.36 (a list is attached and made a part of these minutes),
- 4. To authorize the payments of the bills and payroll for the period February 1-15, totaling \$385,602.63 (a list is attached and made a part of these minutes).

No bids will be considered unless sealed and filed with the clerk and accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, bid bond or certified check payable to the City Administrator for ten percent of the amount of such bid.


